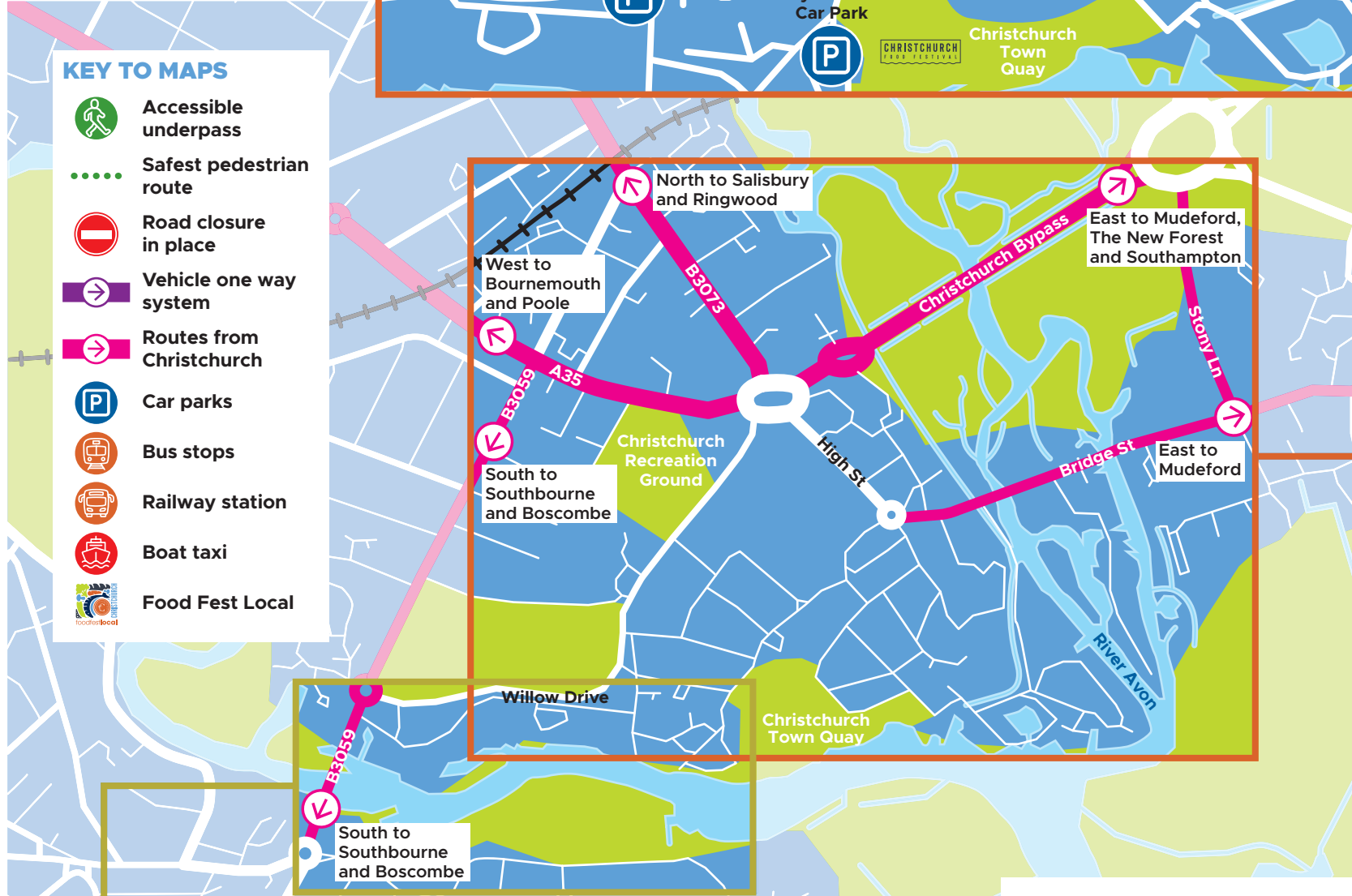
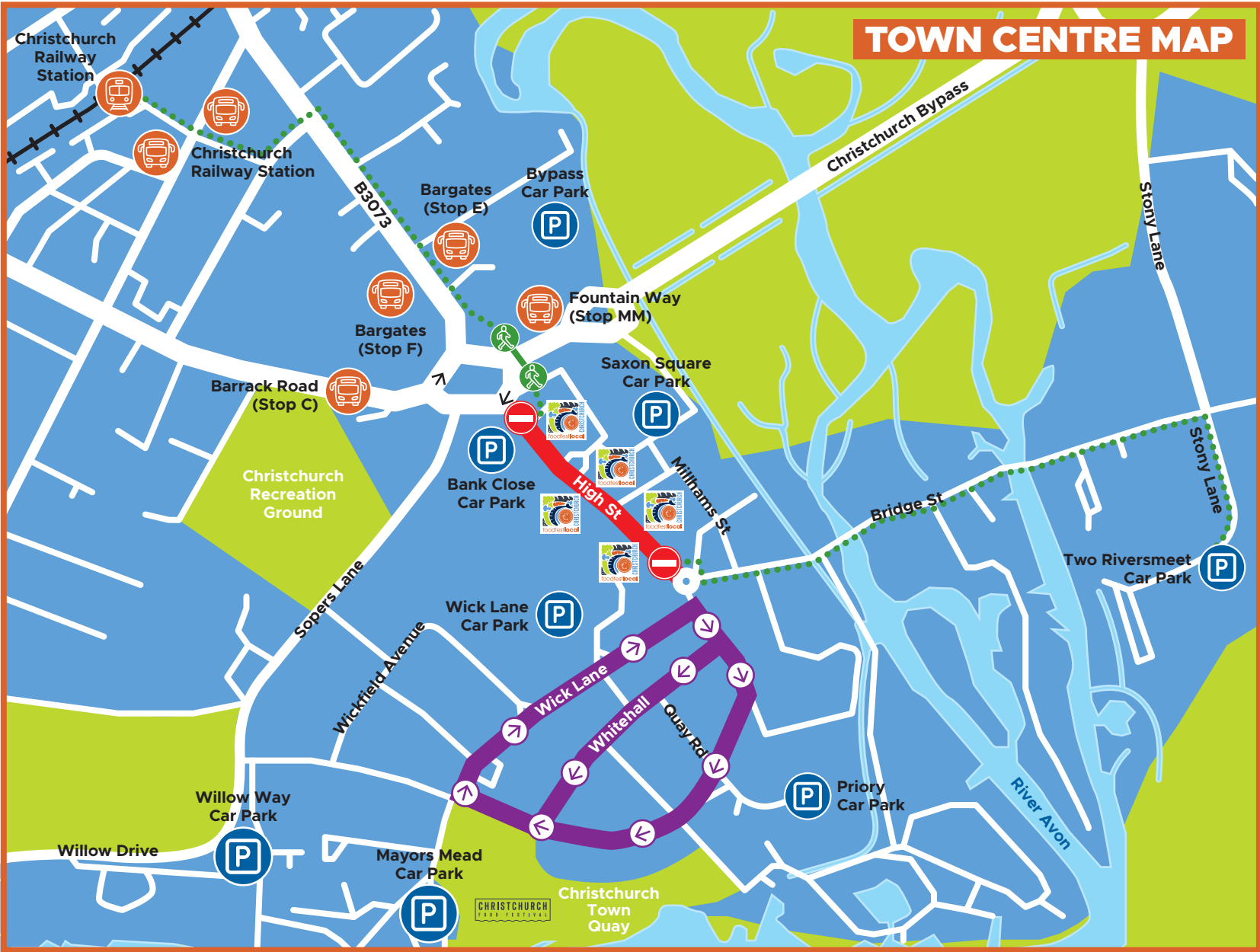
ROAD CLOSURE

Christchurch High Street will be closed for Food Fest Local from **6am-8pm** on both **Saturday and Sunday**. The Monday Market will continue to trade as normal.

BY CAR

In under an hour you can reach Christchurch from Shaftesbury, Salisbury, Southampton, Poole, Wimborne, Fareham, Dorchester and The New Forest.

- From the North & East** take the M27 and then the A338.
- From the East** take the A35 or A31.
- From the South** take the B3059.



BY BUS & TRAIN

Download the **Morebus App** for timetables and fares.

Closest Bus Stops: Fountain Way (MM), Bargates (E), Bargates (F) and Barrack Road (C).

Christchurch Station (CHR), Stour Road, BH23 1PL, is the nearest mainline train station on the South Western Railway 'London Waterloo to Weymouth' line.

Walk to the High Street via Bargates (B3073) in 10 minutes.

HOP ON A FERRY

Tuckton to Wick Ferry is a vintage ferry service that runs from April until October between Tuckton Tea Gardens, Wick Ferry, Christchurch Quay and Mudeford Sandbank for the beach and Hengistbury Head. It's the best way to beat the traffic and have an adventurous trip over to the park at the Quay.

CAR PARKS

There are several car parks available from long to short stay and most offer overnight.

Under 4 hours: Bypass Car Park, Wick Lane, Bank Close & Saxon Square off parking up to 4 hours (not extendable).

Over 4 hours: Priory Car Park, Willow Way, Mayors Mead, Two Riversmeet & Bridge Street all offer long stay parking.

Ringo is the app that serves our car parks, however most car parks take cash too.
